### Boarding Fees

Boarding fees are in addition to tuition fees and cover meals and accommodation.

### Please Note:

- Fees are charged twice a year, in February for Semester 1 and July for Semester 2.

- The College does not issue split bills. Enrolling parents/guardians are responsible jointly and severally for the payment of College tuition fees and other charges.
- The Fee Schedule is reviewed by the College Board of Directors during the annual budgeting process in November.

**Accounts should be settled in full by the end of the calendar year. Should a family have an outstanding fee balance, the College reserves the right to deny the return of a student or the enrolment of a sibling.**
