1. Role Purpose

2. Role Responsibility

The Classroom Teacher is responsible to the Principal via the Assistant Principal Teaching & Learning.

3. Role Accountability

Classroom Management and Procedures

- Incorporate techniques and teaching strategies appropriate to the subject area and the varying needs of the students to reflect contemporary pedagogy.
- Ensure the creation of a positive learning environment
- Communicate praise and feedback to students
- Have adequate lesson preparation
- Begin and end lessons punctually
- Keep an accurate attendance check
- Allocate meaningful homework appropriate to the requirements of the course and give positive feedback
- Ensure the classroom is left in reasonable order
- Reinforce the observance of school rules
- Employ appropriate classroom management techniques and follow procedures in the Student Welfare handbook
- Liaise with Studies or Guidance Coordinators where appropriate.

- Complete Registers as required
- Pursue professional development courses

General Duties and Responsibilities

- Perform supervision and other duties as required
- Take responsibility for their manner of dress so that it is always neat, clean and appropriate.
- Attend parent teacher evenings and other school functions as required
- Actively participate, support and promote school activities
- Support the Pastoral Care of the College by participating in whole College activities eg camps, retreats, homeroom, excursions, assemblies

- Perform supervision and other duties as designated in an active manner. This includes playground and examination supervision, extras, tutorial monitoring and staffroom duties.
